Determinations

Based on my review of project materials including the Biological Evaluation forms (Summer 2019), and in coordination with representatives from NOAA's Protected Resource Division (PRD) and Habitat Conservation Division in the Southeast Regional Office, the NOAA Restoration Center (RC) determined that the following projects will have no effect to species or habitats listed under the Endangered Species Act, designated Essential Fish Habitat or animals protected by the Marine Mammal Protection Act under the jurisdiction of National Marine Fisheries Service (NMFS):

Restoration Type: Fish and Water column invertebrates

- Communication Tools to Reduce Bycatch
- Reduction in Mortality from Barotrauma

Restoration Type: Sea Turtles

- Gulf of Mexico Sea Turtle Atlas
- Long-term Nesting Beach Habitat Protection for Sea Turtles
- Developing a Gulfwide Comprehensive Plan for In-water Sea Turtle Data Collection
- Identifying Methods to Reduce Sea Turtle Bycatch in the Reef Fish Bottom Longline Fishery

Restoration Type: Marine Mammals

 Compilation of Environmental, Threats, and Animal Data for Cetacean Population Health Analyses (CETACEAN)
