Open Ocean TIG RP/EA #2: Activities Covered by Existing Compliance

Based on my review of project materials including the Biological Evaluation forms (Summer 2019), and in coordination with representatives from NOAA's Protected Resource Division (PRD) and Habitat Conservation Division in the Southeast Regional Office, the NOAA Restoration Center (RC) determined that the following projects have existing coverage from previous compliance efforts under one of more of the these statutes: the Endangered Species Act, the Magnuson Stevens Act (designates Essential Fish Habitat) or animals protected by the Marine Mammal Protection Act under the jurisdiction of National Marine Fisheries Service (NMFS).
