SUBJECT: May 2007 Update for the Imnaha River Subbasin Steelhead Weirs

## Operations through the end of May 31, 2007

The Lightning and Cow creek bi-directional adult steelhead weirs operated continually during the month of May except for partial days on May 1, 11 and 13 and all day on the 12<sup>th</sup> in Lightning Creek. Upstream fish are marked with a numbered opercular disk tag to facilitate a mark recapture study. Fish captured in the downstream box are checked for marks and passed downstream.

The Lightning Creek weir marked and passed 11 unique adult steelhead upstream (one was a hatchery fish) and passed 11 unique fish (one was a hatchery fish) downstream of which 5 were mortalities. Nine recaptured steelhead (two were hatchery fish) were passed downstream in Lightning Creek of which five were mortalities. The Cow Creek bi-directional weir passed six unique steelhead upstream and passed two unique and five recaptured steelhead downstream. One of the unique downstream fish and three of the downstream recaptures were mortalities. - 1) Lightning Creek weir trapping started on February 28, 2007.
- 2) Cow Creek weir trapping started on March 1, 2007.
- 3) All first time captured fish are scanned for CWT and PIT Tags and checked for external marks. They receive a double LOP (left opercle punch used as a genetic sample) and a Tyvek Disc tag on their right opercle.
- 4) Male/female distinction based on morphometric characters.
- 5) Monthly report data summaries should be considered preliminary. Ongoing database validation/corrections may result in slight discrepancies from month to month.
