Florida Panther Recovery Implementation Team Meeting Summary

May 6 and 14, 2014 Teleconferences

The primary purpose of these teleconferences was to prepare for the Panther Public Forum on May 22nd at Archbold Biological Station.

Preliminary Meetings with Stakeholders

Several Team members held two small group meetings with stakeholders (one with landowners and the other with representatives from conservation NGOs) to discuss the Payment for Ecosystem Services concept and the Alternative Options Matrix prior to the Forum so we could receive early feedback about each of those documents before presenting them to the public. The list of stakeholders who were invited to each of those meetings is attached, and attendees are highlighted.

We received a lot of good, diverse comments about the documents during discussions at both preliminary meetings. Several NGO representatives also submitted written comments. For consistency, the Team agreed to not change the documents prior to the Forum, and instead to incorporate some of the comments during the presentations. We will consider all comments received for revision of the documents after the Forum.

Stakeholder Forum Preparation

The Team mainly discussed logistics in preparation for the FL Panther Public Forum. An announcement was posted on the Team website the end of April, and invitations were also sent to a number of landowners and associated organizations, as well as conservation organizations, local governments and State officials.

Perran Ross will serve as facilitator to provide the ground rules and keep us on schedule. Dawn will prepare an annotated agenda for the Team to use.

Agency staff will be assigned to assist with attendee sign-in, participant questions and comments (handling the microphone), making handouts, and taking notes.

Transportation Subteam

Appointment letters will need to be signed by the Service's SE Regional Director – that authority could not be delegated, so Larry will send the letters to her.

Population Subteam

Recommendations for the Population Subteam include researchers and others who have collected panther density and/or locality data (Darrell Land, Roy McBride, David Onorato, David Shindle) as well as a human dimensions specialist (Ann Forstchen) to help the public better understand how the population estimate will be derived. FWC will be discussing this at the June Commission meeting.
