M/V Selendang Ayu Oil Spill Natural Resource Damage Assessment and Restoration

Trustee Resolution 2018-01:

Reimbursement of Costs Incurred October 21, 2015 through December 31, 2017 and

Release of Restoration Planning Funds

- 1. Whereas, the United States Department of the Interior (DOI), acting through the United States Fish and Wildlife Service (USFWS), the United States Department of Commerce, acting through the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (NOAA), and the State of Alaska, acting through the Departments of Environmental Conservation (ADEC), Fish and Game (ADFG), Law (ADOL), and Natural Resources (ADNR), are the six Natural Resource Trustee agencies ("Trustee agencies") responsible for the natural resource damage assessment and restoration (NRDAR) associated with the 2004 M/V Selendang Ayu oil spill that occurred along the northern shore of Unalaska Island, Alaska;
- 2. Whereas, on November 25, 2016, the Trustee agencies submitted to the United States Coast Guard's National Pollution Funds Center (NPFC) a request for funding to reimburse the agencies for past assessment costs and to support the agencies' future efforts to complete the injury assessment and restoration planning work and to prepare a Restoration Plan (hereinafter, the "November 2016 claim");
- 3. Whereas, as a result of the November 2016 claim, the NPFC awarded funding to the Trustee agencies in 2017 in the amounts of (a) \$1,236,943.47 as reimbursement of the agencies' past assessment costs up to October 20, 2015 and (b) \$2,462,117.00 for the agencies' future work to complete the injury assessment and restoration planning work and to prepare a Restoration Plan; and these funds were deposited into the DOI NRDAR Fund, Account #0451, on behalf of the agencies;
- 4. Whereas, the Trustee agencies incurred costs related to the M/V Selendang Ayu NRDAR from October 21, 2015 through December 31, 2017, for which, at the time of submitting the November 2016 claim, the agencies intended to eventually receive reimbursement from the NPFC award for future costs;
- 5. Whereas, the USFWS, ADEC, ADFG, ADOL, and ADNR now seek reimbursement for uncompensated costs incurred from October 21, 2015 through December 31, 2017, in the amounts shown in Table 1, while NOAA will seek reimbursement at a later time;

- 6. Whereas, after careful review of the cost documentation (Exhibits 1-5) for costs incurred from October 21, 2015 through December 31, 2017 provided by each Trustee agency seeking reimbursement under this Resolution, the Trustee agencies find that:
 - (a) the incurred costs are reasonable and appropriate for the M/V Selendang Ayu NRDAR,
 - (b) the incurred costs are in accordance with the Assessment Plan for the M/V Selendang Ayu NRDAR and adhere to the limitations imposed by the NPFC on the use of the 2017 award,
 - (c) the incurred costs are sufficiently supported by cost documentation,
 - (d) the cumulative expenditures within each Activity do not exceed the amount authorized by the NPFC, and
 - (e) the cumulative expenditures of each Trustee agency do not exceed the amounts budgeted for each agency and agreed to by the agencies during the development of the November 2016 claim after adjustment to account for the amounts denied by the NPFC;
- 7. Whereas, the ADFG wishes to receive in advance all of the funds budgeted for that agency in the November 2016 claim for future work, after accounting for the budget adjustments associated with the funding denied by the NPFC and after accounting for the reimbursement of costs incurred from October 21, 2015 to December 31, 2017 shown in Table 1; these advance funds (\$127,255.86) will be used to support work in accordance with the Assessment Plan, and any funds remaining unspent after conclusion of the Assessment Plan activities, shall be returned to the DOI NRDAR Fund, Account #0451;
- 8. Whereas, the ADEC, ADOL, and ADNR will periodically seek reimbursements for case-related costs incurred after December 31, 2017, rather than receive full advance funding at this time, and the Trustee agencies concur that total amounts remaining available to ADEC, ADOL, and ADNR are shown in Table 2 after accounting for the budget adjustments associated with the funding denied by the NPFC and accounting for the reimbursement of costs incurred from October 21, 2015 to December 31, 2017 shown in Table 1; and
