Red Wolf Program: Join refuge staff in learning about the history and biology of red wolves. Programs include a talk about the red wolves and the ability to visit the live red wolves at the red wolf center. Programs are only offered at the times listed.

There is no guarantee that you will be able to see the exhibit red wolves as they are a shy and elusive species

Bear Tour: Starting June 14th, join refuge staff in learning the history and biology of black bears while having the opportunity to view black bears in their natural habitat through this guided walking tour.

Bear tours will not be provided during inclement weather as road conditions on the Pungo Unit can become hazardous in wet conditions

Preschool Program: Starting June 14th, join refuge staff for weekly preschool aged nature time with engaging wildlife and nature themed activities. Weather permitting, youth participants and their guardians will go outside to explore the natural world along the Scuppernong River.
