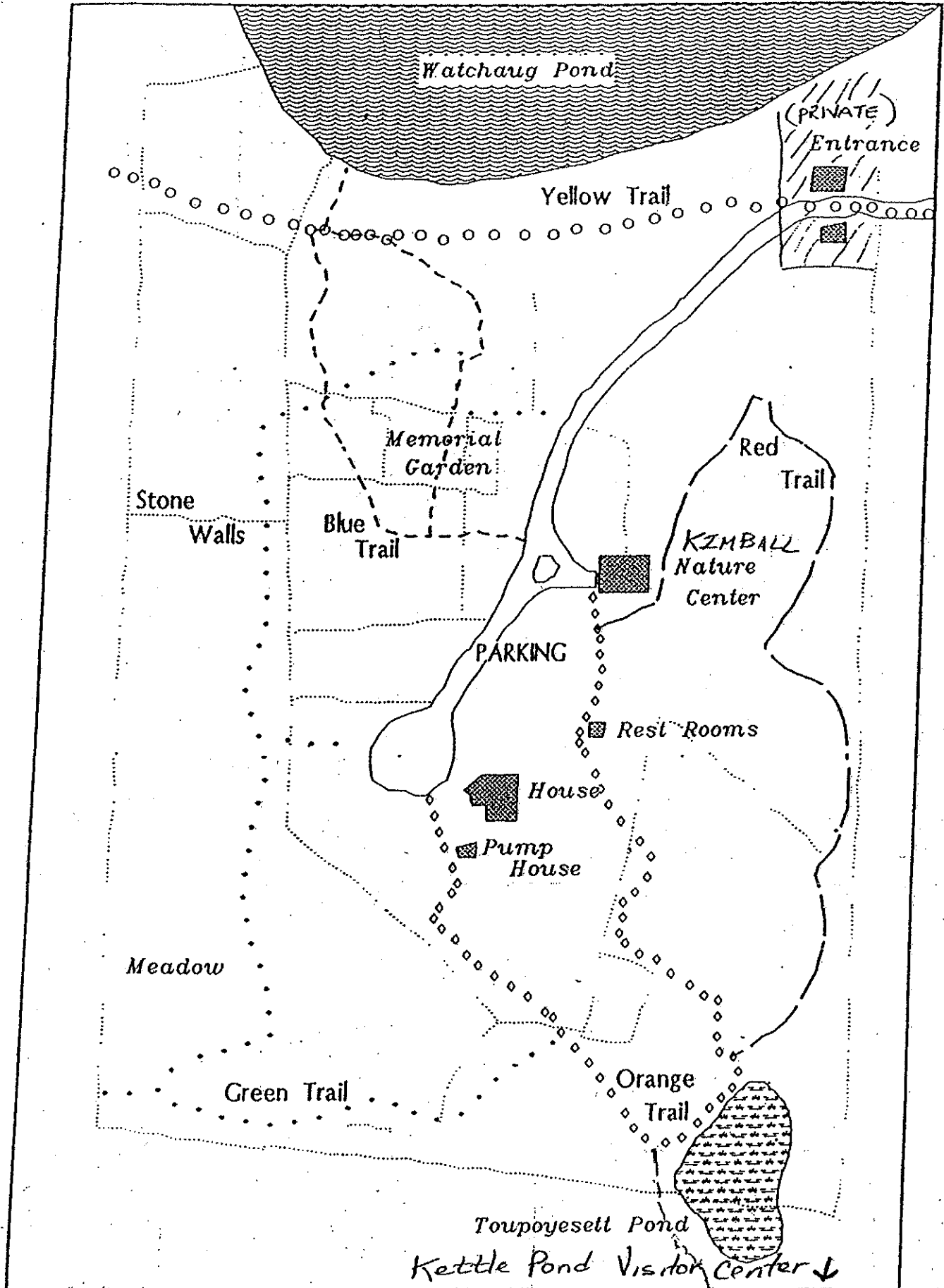


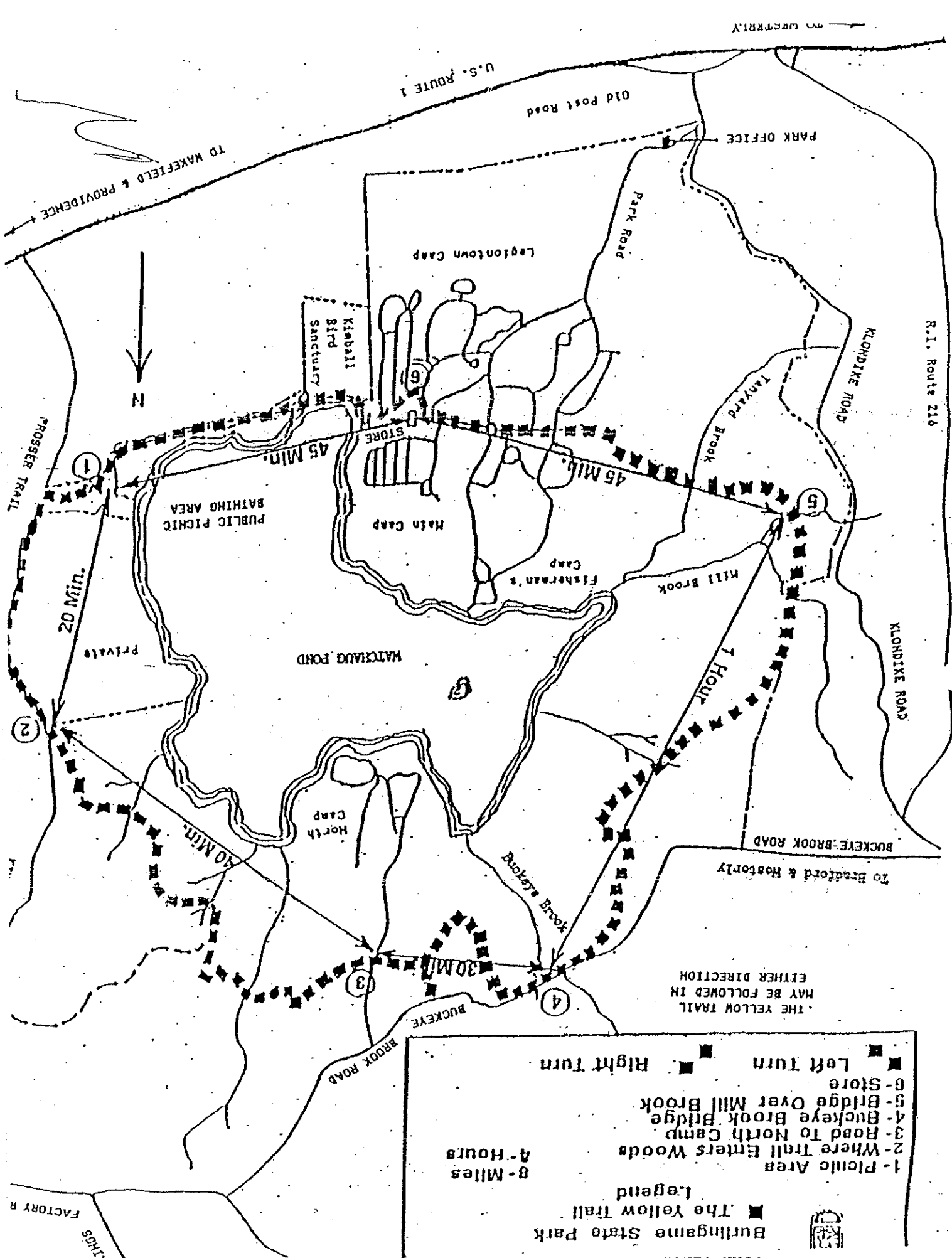
# Kimball
