This letter continues our response to your Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request dated November 2, 2021 regarding the following:

From January 1, 2015, all email records and correspondence related to the Jamestown S’Klallam Tribe’s Dungeness Bay Oyster Farm by USFWS Dungeness National Wildlife Refuge (DNWR) staff, including emails between Service staff, with other federal and state agencies (e.g., U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, Environmental Protection Agency, Washington State Department of Ecology and Washington State Department of Natural Resources), nonprofit public interest groups (e.g., Protect the Peninsula’s Future, Coalition to Protect Puget Sound Habitat and Friends of the Dungeness National Wildlife Refuge) and private citizens. We would like copies of all electronic records and emails dating back to January 1, 2015.

We are releasing to you today via Fileshare 175 records in full. We continue to review records and will release more in the future in rolling releases.
