Only one entry can be submitted per participant, the photo must be taken by participant, must be taken on refuge in open areas, the subject matter cannot be captive and must be native to the refuge, and photos may be enhanced but not photoshopped. All writing or information shown on the photo must be removed.

To submit your photograph, email a high-quality version to grace_thomas@fws.gov along with a signed and completed entry form, a copyright release form, and a use of likeness form (if there is a recognizable individual within the photograph).

When entering the photo contest, photographers will be donating the photo to the refuge as well as the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service. If you would like to retain the rights to your photos this contest is not for you. Credits to the photographer will still be given.
