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#### Pea Island Bird Walk

FREE. Pea Island is for the birds - actually! Pea Island National Wildlife Refuge has close to 400 species of birds that live here or pass through. Whether you're a beginner or an expert, you'll enjoy this casual stroll beside North Pond. Field guides, binoculars, sunscreen, and insect repellent are recommended. Some field guides and binoculars will be available for loan. Pea Island Bird Walks are held year-round except during the Wings Over Water Wildlife Festival in October and December. Meet at the Pea Island National Wildlife Refuge Visitor Center, located on NC Highway 12 approximately 4 miles south of Oregon Inlet and 9 miles north of Rodanthe.

### Beach Clean-up

FREE. Join Refuge staff to help keep our beaches clean! Meet at the parking area on NC Highway 12 north of the Jughandle Bridge, 6 miles south of the Pea Island National Wildlife Refuge Visitors Center. Wear comfortable clothes, sturdy shoes, and work gloves; if you have them, bring a 5 gallon bucket and/or grabber. We'll go over a quick safety talk and then head out onto the beaches to pick up trash wherever it's needed most. Wind or rain will cancel.

### ecoEXPLORE Ichthyology Discovery

FREE. Learn about ecoEXPLORE from refuge staff and celebrate ichthyology season by investigating fish of coastal North Carolina! Meet at the Coastal North Carolina NWR Complex Gateway Visitors Center, 100 Conservation Way, Manteo, NC. ecoEXPLORE is an incentive-based community science program for children in grades K-8.

#### **Red Wolf Tour**

FREE. Join refuge staff for a guided program on the endangered red wolf! Tours will begin with an introduction to the history and biology of the red wolf. From there, participants will return to their vehicles and follow staff along the wildlife drive within the home range of wild red wolf family group. These tours do not guarantee that participants will see a wild red wolf, but they do serve as an opportunity to showcase the vast territory of the only wild red wolf population. Programs will not be offered in inclement weather. Meet at the Creef Cut Wildlife Trail Parking Lot, located on Alligator River National Wildlife Refuge at Milltail Road and Hwy 64 W approximately 6 miles west of Manns Harbor.

## Wings Over Water Wildlife Festival

This annual national wildlife refuge fundraising event features over 70 birding, paddling, photography, art & natural history programs. The festival takes place across 6 northeast North Carolina counties, including National Wildlife Refuges, National Parks and Seashores, North Carolina State Parks, The Nature Conservancy Preserves, and other natural areas. It is one of the premier east coast wildlife festivals. Programs offer great, knowledgeable activity leaders along with a small ratio of participants-to-leader and wonderful wildlife opportunities.
