Red Wolf Program: Join refuge staff in learning about the history and biology of Red Wolves. Programs include a talk about the Red Wolves and the ability to visit the exhibit Red Wolves at the Red Wolf Center. Scheduled programs are the only opportunity that visitors can view the exhibit Red Wolves.

*****There is no guarantee that you will be able to see the exhibit Red Wolves as they are a shy and elusive species*****

Wintering Waterfowl Tour: Join refuge staff for a guided tour of the Pungo Unit to observe the magnificent migratory waterfowl. The tour will provide details about the role Pungo plays in providing a waterfowl sanctuary and include information on Tundra Swan and other migrating waterfowl! This is a caravan tour with participants driving their own vehicle following the tour leader. Vehicles are subject to road conditions on the Pungo Unit. It is recommended to arrive with a full tank of gas and to be driving in a 4WD capable vehicle to avoid getting stuck on the refuge. Roads on the refuge have a weight limit of 8,000lbs. The tour will begin at the Pungo Unit Kiosk located near 600 Refuge Rd Pantego, NC at the corner of Pat's Rd and Refuge Rd. **There is a sign at the kiosk stating "Refuge Tour Meets Here."**
