Eastern Neck National Wildlife Refuge (refuge) will host its annual mentored youth turkey hunt in partnership with the National Wild Turkey Federation on April 12 and April 19, 2025. To apply please review the instructions and email the completed application by 3pm on March 21st to easternneck@fws.gov. All youth selected must attend a mandatory virtual orientation on April 9th at 6pm and will be assigned one hunt day.

Eastern Neck National Wildlife Refuge is part of the Chesapeake Marshlands National Wildlife Refuge Complex, U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service. The refuge is one of 573 national wildlife refuges in the United States which primary objective is to provide habitat for the conservation and protection of wildlife. The refuge is an island located at the confluence of the Chester River and the Chesapeake Bay and provides important migration and wintering habitat for migratory birds, namely waterfowl. 2025 YOUTH TURKEY HUNT INSTRUCTIONS EASTERN NECK NATIONAL WILDLIFE REFUGE Department of the Interior - U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service

Application Instructions:

- 1. Only youths ages 12 through 16 on the day of the hunt who were not chosen for previous youth turkey hunts are eligible.
- 2. All interested applicants must complete a Hunt Application form. Under 'Hunt Date Choices', please indicate your first and second choice for your hunt date April 12 or April 19, 2025. If you are selected and your first date choice is full, you will be offered your second date choice. Both the applicant and the applicant's parent or guardian must sign the form.
- 3. Fill out and sign the Agreement for Use of Likeness in Audio/Visual Products form.
- 4. Completed application forms must be received by **3pm on Friday**, **March 21**, **2025** to be entered into the lottery. Email completed forms (scanned or Adobe PDFs preferred) to <u>easternneck@fws.gov</u>. Illegible applications (i.e. blurry photos) may not be included in the lottery.

Information/Regulations:

- 1. The drawing to select youth hunters will be held on **Monday, March 24, 2025**, and all successful applicants will be notified by email on **March 24, 2025**.
- 2. Youth hunters must email (<u>easternneck@fws.gov</u>) their valid state hunting license **one week prior to the hunt day** and are required to attend a mandatory virtual orientation on **April 9, 2025 at 6pm**. Youth hunters must carry their valid state hunting license with them on the day of the hunt.
- 3. The morning briefing will be held at 5am the day of the hunt at the Tundra Swan Boardwalk located at the entrance of the refuge.
- 4. Youth hunters must be accompanied by the assigned licensed, non-hunting adult provided by the National Wild Turkey Federation who will act as a mentor. Youths may also be accompanied by a non-hunting parent or guardian.
- Legal hunting hours are one-half hour before sunrise to noon. Sunrise April 12, 2025: 6:32am Sunrise April 19, 2025: 6:22am
- 6. Loaded weapons are not permitted in parking areas or on paved or graveled roads.
- 7. Hunting of turkey is permitted only in designated areas of the refuge. See Youth Turkey Hunt Zone map.
- 8. Bag limit is one bearded turkey.
- 9. All other Maryland State rules and regulations related to the state's spring turkey season are applicable and will be enforced during the special hunt on the refuge.

PRIVACY ACT STATEMENT

Authority: The information requested is authorized by the National Wildlife Refuge System Administration Act (16 U.S.C. 668dd-ee) as amended and the Refuge Recreation Act (16 U.S.C. 460k – 460k-4, 640K-3, & 664).
