Work on mission-critical projects:

- You will train under a seasoned maintenance worker and heavy equipment operator to gain technical expertise and project management skills.
- You will have the opportunity to work with both station maintenance and regional maintenance action teams in the upkeep of real property assets and habitat management

The fellowships are paid, include benefits, and are typically 52 weeks.
