


Exhibit C.1: Burke Ranch Conservation Bank Vernal Pool Service Area






Figure III-9. Northeastern Sacramento Valley vernal pool region.






Figure 3. Bank Service Area (Map Source: Rand McNally Redding and Red Bluff California, 1989)


