The U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service (USFWS) is the premier government agency dedicated to the conservation, protection and echancement of fish, wildlife, plants, and their habitats, The USFWS also helps ensure a healthy environment for people by protecting such ecosystem services as clean air and water.

The Savannah Coastal Refugees Complex (SCRC) is a group of 7 National Wildlife Refuges (NWRs) spanning over 100 miles along the coast of South Carolina and Georgia. These include Savannah, Pinckney Island, Harris Neck, Wassaw, Blackbeard Island, Tybee, and Wolf Island NWRs. The SCRC headquarters is located at the Savannah National Wildlife Refuge, near Hardeeville, South Carolina.

Geocaching is an outdoor adventure game played with a GPS device. The basic idea is to locate hidden containers, called "geocaches," sign a logbook, and share your experience online.



Steps to Participate in the Savannah Coastal Refuges GeoTrail

- 1 Obtain a Savannah Coastal Refuges Complex GeoTrail passport from the Visitor Center (hours and location below).
- **2** Go to www.geocaching.com, log in or create a new account.
- 3 Find the coordinates for the 7 Geocaches, listed below. Follow the directions found on each geocache's web page to locate each cache.
- **4** When you find one of the GeoTrail geocaches, write your name in the logbook with the date you found it, and use the stamp in the container to punch your passport for that
