



SUMMER JOB FOR TEENS



Kodiak Refuge Youth Conservation Corps (YCC)

To apply: Application must be received by Friday April 14th, 4pm.
Employment Period: Part time, running approximately June 12-August 11th
 Hours vary between 12-40 hours per week. Most work will take place on the Kodiak road system with 2-3 possible trips in the field that will be five days in length. All local, state, and federal workplace policies must be followed.



Some examples of duties/learning opportunities:

- Invasive species, environmental research and monitoring, trail work, maintenance, assisting with youth programs, helping at the visitor center, and more.
- Training in CPR/First Aid and Bear Awareness/Safety.

To be eligible for the Youth Conservation Corps, applicants must:

1. Be 15-18 years of age.
2. Wear the YCC uniform in a neat, clean manner.
3. Have housing in the community of Kodiak.
4. Be prepared to work outdoors on rainy days and indoors on sunny days – it happens.
5. Have transportation to and from work, primarily meeting at the Refuge Visitor Center.

- Complete the application form that is available on our website (<https://www.fws.gov/refuge/kodiak>), in person at the Refuge Visitor Center or at the Kodiak Job Center. Forms must be received by the due date to be considered for the position. See below.
