



# JUNIOR RANGER AT HOME Cereal Box Wildlife Window Craft

All done with that box of cereal? Don't throw it away - use it to create your very own "wildlife window." This window can help you focus in on animal tracks, feathers, clouds and so much more!


## You Will Need:

- Cereal box, any size
- Popsicle stick or any stick
- Scissors
- Ruler or measuring tape
- Glue or stapler
- Crayons or markers



**1.** Open the box until it is one, flat piece. Use the ruler to trace a rectangle that is 7 inches wide by 9 inches long. Repeat this step (need front and back). Hint: If you use the crease of the box fold it will make cutting the box easier (see picture).

**2.** Cut out the rectangles. Use the ruler again to create the "window" by measuring 1 and 1/2 inches on each edge, creating another rectangle. Cut the rectangle out of both pieces (see picture).



**3.** Glue or staple the "image" side of the cereal boxes together. On one side, between the 2 rectangles, glue or staple the popsicle stick for wildlife window handle (see picture above).

**4.** Using crayons or markers decorate your Wildlife Window with animal tracks, cloud names, bugs or whatever! Remember to take a picture and share it with us on Facebook @SoutheastLouisiana
