## Nature Easter Eggs

If you can't find eggs to dye this Easter, these Nature Easter Eggs are such a fun alternative! They're easy to make, get kids outside and allow them to be as creative as they want!

### You Will Need:

1. Cardboard or cereal box
2. Pencil
3. Scissors
4. Glue
5. Natural decorations



- 1.** Go outside with your favorite adult and collect a variety of different natural decorations for your egg. Try to get a variety of different shapes, colors and sizes of objects. Example: grass clippings, flowers, seeds, branches, etc.



- 2.** Open the cereal box until it is one, flat piece or use a piece of cardboard. Draw an egg shape with a pencil - make it whatever size.



- 3.** Cut out the egg - you can make more than one!



- 4.** Using glue, start decorating your egg with the different natural decorations. Remember, Ranger Becky says that you can never have too much glue!
