

# JUNIOR RANGER AT HOME

## Easy Steps to Draw a Goose

Get creative today and learn from these easy steps on how to draw a goose. Enter your artwork into the Louisiana Junior Duck Stamp Contest - entries due March 31.



### You Will Need:

- Paper, 9 x 12 size
- A pencil to start
- Crayons, colored pencils, paint or other colors
- Reference pictures of ducks, geese or swans



- 1 Use basic shapes. An oval for the body, circle for the head, triangles for the tail and wing feathers, another triangle for the beak, a rectangle for the neck. Hint: most geese stand at an angle, so draw your oval at an angle.
- 2 Connect the shapes by outlining your goose. Add more details to the head, wings or tail. Add shapes for feet, outline and refine. Hint: Put the goose in water or sitting on land to avoid drawing feet.
- 3 Add color. This will make your goose look even more realistic. Start with basic colors and then add in shading/contrast colors to give more depth.
- 4 Don't forget to add habitat in background - find out where the goose lives to help draw it's habitat.
