# JUNIOR RANGER AT HOME

## Plastic Bottle Jellyfish

Do you have empty plastic bottle in your trash? Don't throw it away just yet, use it to create your very plastic bottle jellyfish! So grab your favorite adult, follow these simple steps and learn more about World Ocean Day!

### You Will Need:

1. Plastic Bottle(s)
2. Scissors
3. Glue or tape
4. Paint and paint brush
5. Plastic Bag
6. Hole puncher (optional)



**1.** Using scissors, cut the bottom off of the plastic bottle (you may need your favorite adult to assist). Remember to trim after to ensure there are no sharp edges.



**2.** Using non-washable paint, decorate the inside and outside of the plastic bottle bottom. Let paint dry for at least an hour or overnight.



**3.** While your jellyfish body is drying cut plastic bag into strips - these will be used for the tentacles.

**4.** Optional - using a hole puncher, pop 5 holes around the edge of the plastic bottle bottom. If you don't have a hole punch that is OK - just use tape.

**5.** Tie or tape plastic bag pieces around the bottom of the plastic bottle for the jellyfish tentacles. All done! Remember to share your creations with us on Facebook @SoutheastLouisiana.
